The project was finished on budget.
- 2) New handicap parking lot was poured, thank you to all the volunteers, tearing out damaged concrete, setting the forms, installing the rebar. Thank you to Roger Dreckman Construction for giving us a discounted price for concrete and labor at no charge, to pour the concrete.
