Meeting called to order 6:29 p.m.

Father opened with a prayer

March 2021 minutes were reviewed.

Motion made by Leon to approve the minutes, seconded by Jon.

Review of Financial Statements

Contributions are running ahead of last year, aided by an estate bequest and an increase in memorials

Expenses are running lower than last year, primarily because we had significant expense for rectory kitchen remodel last year

Motion made by Jon to approve the Financial Statements, seconded by Matt.

Financial / Pastoral Business:

- a. Additional investments (approximately \$100,0000) are being transferred to St. John's from the Julius P. Frana estate. It was decided to keep the investments at the broker rather than cash them in and transfer the funds to Dubuque.
- b. Council Officers - Patty Einwalter agreed to remain on the council for another term.
- c. CFAD Distribution - motion made by Jon, second by Matt to reinvest the interest earned on the Heineman Endowment
- d. COVID Mass Precautions - cluster council to decide, however our recommendation is to follow CDC guidelines
- e. The Bishop has reinstated the Mass obligation beginning the weekend of June 5 - 6

Building and Grounds Business

- a. Glass repair - Father has contacted a different vendor (same as used by Waucoma and Little Turkey)
- b. Sacristy door - Panos Construction to look at it
- c. Rectory driveway - has cracked and settled. Dave to get bids on getting it raised or replaced. Not urgent at this time.
- d. Altar - The altar found in storage in Protivin was refurbished for free by the company painting the Waucoma church. It has now been placed in service here at St. John's. Motion by Matt, seconded by Leon to donate \$1,000 to the Waucoma church painting project. Value of the altar refurbishment was much more than this. Part of this cost is offset by \$895 received from Fr. John Secora, in memorial of his mother. Fr. Secora also donated two candlesticks.

Fr. Radloff closed the meeting with a prayer.
