**Buildings and Grounds**

- (1) Wet spot found in NE corner of choir loft on wall, possible causes, steeple, shingles or tuck pointing, Krause Construction has been contacted to ensure that water infiltration is not coming from the recent steeple repairs and investigate possible sources of leak.
- (2) Heater for east doors will be installed on sill to prevent doors from freezing at bottom due to condensation. Small heater will be installed in vestibule to reduce condensation, work to be performed by Steve Kuennen and Mike Hensley.
- (3) Bat-Away will be placed in basement to eliminate bats.
- (4) Lawn spraying will be done by Ronnie Franzen.
- (5) Dylan Knox will be mowing lawn again this year.
- (6) (6) Outer stain glasses have BB gun holes, repairs to be done by Staige Stain Glass Restoration at a cost of \$2,800.00. Motion by Steve Kuennen and seconded by Ken Hemesath, approved.
